Cemetery Fees 2025

Table of fees, payments and sums fixed and settled under Section 34 of the Burial Act 1852, by the Parish Council of Willington, acting as the Burial Authority for the Parish of Willington.

1. Interments (burials)

Willington Parish Council does not provide a grave digging service for burials.

All plots are double depth.

Burials - Under 16 years - Resident	Free
Burials – Over the age of 16 at time of death - Resident	£551
Burials – over the age of 16 at time of death – Non-Resident	£1818
Burials – subsequent burials after first	£495
Burial of cremated remains – 16 years and under	Free
Burial of cremated remains – 16 years and over	£164
Burial of cremated remains after first	£164

2. Exclusive Rights of Burial – for 50 years and 25-year extension

Grant of right for a period of 50 years – grave (adult or child)	£992
Grant of right for a period of 25 years (extension following initial 50) – grave (adult or child)	£450
Grant of right for a period of 50 years – ashes plot	£363
Grant of right for a period of 25 years (extension following initial 50) – ashes plot	£165

3. Headstones and tablets – licence to erect and maintain for 30 years

Headstones not exceeding 762 750 mm height	£330
Ashes tablet	£164
Any additional inscription on any of above	£142

North side of Cemetery only (left of the path as you enter):

Headstones not exceeding 762mm (30") in height	£330
Kerbstone or borderstones, with or without rails, chains or palisades, enclosing a space not exceeding 2 m by 1 m	£317
Any additional inscription on any of above	£142

Double plots only.

4. Administration and other fees

Transfer of ownership	£50
Search of records	£100 (to include a copy of the entry)
Exhumation	£1228

5. Eligibility

The foregoing fees are to be applied where the deceased has lived in the Parish of Willington for 12 months prior to his/her interment. This is to be verified by inclusion on the electoral role.

In consideration of special circumstances e.g. where a Parishioner of Willington has not lived in the village for 12 months prior to his/her interment, interment may be permissible at the Clerk's discretion, subject to double the foregoing fees, payments and sums.

Reservation of plots for burials or interment of ashes is not permitted.

At a meeting of the Parish Council of Willington held on the 7th January 2025, the foregoing fees, payments and sums, payable under Section 34 of the Burial Act 1852, are hereby fixed and settled by the said Parish Council, to commence from 15th January 2025.
