To consider options for the replacement:

Options received:

Option 1 (sourced by Cllr. Allsopp)

Hi Phillip,

Thanks for dropping in yesterday.

As discussed I have the following suggestions for the Station Garden.

Christmas tree - Abies Nordmanniana 200/250cm in 80L container planted £750.

As an alternative as discussed we could supply either  
3 betula jacquemontii 10/12 girth bare root planted at £250 each  
3 liquidamber slender silhouette 8/10 girth in 45L containers at £290 each planted  
A single multistemmed betula jacquemontii 300/350cm 45L container at £650 planted  
Prunus amanagowa (pole cherry) 12/14cm 70L container £380 planted  
Prunus amanagowa (pole cherry) 8/10cm girth bare root £180 planted  
Or combination thereof.

Let me know your thoughts.

Option 2 (sourced by Cllr. Mead)

The tree would be one that has been grown in a pot in the ground so that when it's dug up the roots aren't disturbed. The tree is then planted complete with the pot which will break down after a couple of years as the roots push through it. Estimated price is £250 for an 8 – 10-foot tree (price dependent on final size) and we would have to go and pick it up – we have access to a car and trailer to do so. The tree farm opens middle of November so would need a decision from the PC before then, and a few volunteers to dig the hole for the tree!!
